

BYLAW No. 37/94

A bylaw to Establish a Waste Disposal Area

The Council of The resort Village of Sunset Cove, in the province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:

(a) refuse means:

(i) Household Waste, Grass clippings, Glass, Metal tins, Sawdust, Wet Wastes, Animal Wastes, Vacuum Cleaner Waste and Ashes.

(ii) Lumber, shrubs and trees less than 4 feet in length.

(b) solid waste means all Carcasses of Animals and all Filth, Rubbish, Manure, Refuse, Ofal, Night Soil, Automobile Parts, Building Materials, Household Hazardous Wastes, Furniture, Major Appliances, Sod, Tires, Used Oil and garbage not described in section 1 (b) of this bylaw

(c) Waste disposal area means lands described in section 2 (a) of this bylaw.

2 (a) The land described herein, designated by The Resort Village of Sunset Cove as a waste disposal area, is hereby declared to be a Waste Disposal Area for The Resort Village of Sunset Cove, namely the Waste Disposal Bins on the east side of the road allowance west of Section 28 Township 21 Range 22 West of the 2nd Meridian.

(b) The roll off dumpster placed on The Resort Village of Sunset Cove property, for solid waste and refuse cleanup, during the month of May.

(c) The Regional Waste Management Disposal Ground.

3 (a) All refuse described in Section 1(a) of this bylaw, and taken to the waste disposal area described in Section 2(a) of this bylaw shall be placed in the Waste Disposal Bins provided.

i) All dangerous items such as Broken Glass, Fluorescent Tubes or other sharp objects must be packaged and marked as to contents;

ii) All wastes such as Grass Clippings, Sawdust, Wet Wastes, Animal Wastes, Vacuum Cleaner Waste and Ashes must be bagged and tied;

iii) clippings from shrubs and trees must be tied in bundles less than 1.2 m (4 feet) in length.

(b) All solid waste and garbage or waste not described in section 1 of this bylaw, shall be drawn to and deposited in the locations as set out in section 2(b) the roll off Dumpster or Section 2(c) the Regional Waste Management Disposal Ground.

4. No person shall dump any Solid Waste as defined in Section 1(b), of this bylaw, in the waste disposal area provided for in Section 2(a) of this bylaw.
5. No person shall dump or place any of the items mentioned in Section 4, of this bylaw, near, beside or on the roadway leading to the Waste Disposal Area (Waste Disposal Bins) described in section 2 (a) of this bylaw.
6. All refuse not otherwise provided for by bylaw or resolution of council or by notice of the medical health officer, shall be drawn to and deposited on the said Regional Waste Management Disposal Ground and disposed of to the satisfaction of the health officer.
7. No person shall dump or place any of the items mentioned in Section 4, of this bylaw, in or near the gate, or on the roadway leading to the Regional Waste Management Disposal Ground.
8. No person shall dump or place any of the items mentioned in section 4, of this bylaw, at a place other the areas designed within the Regional Waste Management Disposal Ground.
9. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction shall be liable to the penalty provided for by the General Penalty Bylaw of The Resort Village of Sunset Cove or other specified penalty.
10. Bylaw No. 5 1983 adopted by resolution of Council, on May 4, 1983 is hereby repealed.
