Covid-19 Plan

Gerry Argue's Plaque Unveiling

July 14th 2020

The Chief Medical Health Officer issues public health orders under the authority of The Public Health Act, 1994. For the July 14th 2020 ceremony the following requirements are to be followed to abide by the requirements of the ***Re-Open Saskatchewan Plan***.

1. As per the outdoor gatherings requirements, a maximum of 30 people are permitted to be in attendance during this event. (We expect about 20 people from our resort to attend, a couple of others plus a member or two from the media).
2. If you are experiencing any flu-type symptoms, please don't attend this event.
3. Individuals identified by a Medical Health Officer as having COVID-19 or a close contact to someone with COVID-19 may not attend due to the public health threat they pose.
4. Individuals who are household members or close contacts of a person or persons with COVID-19 may not attend due to the public health threat they pose.
5. Individuals who have travelled internationally within 14 days of this date may not attend this ceremony due to the public health threat they pose.
6. Vulnerable individuals, such as seniors and those with underlying health conditions, should continue to exercise caution and take precautions to minimize all high-risk exposures.
7. Up to 10 days after this ceremony, anyone in attendance must call the Saskatchewan Health-Line at 811 if they become symptomatic.
8. Masks and gloves are not mandatory for outdoor events. However, non-medical masks (e.g. cloth or other materials) are an additional measure you can take to protect people around you when physical distancing cannot be maintained or is unpredictable.

9. A table with hand sanitizer will be situated at the entrance of the pathway leading to the lookout.
10. No food or beverages will be served or available.
11. There will be very limited seating available during this short ceremony, expected to be no more than 10-15 minutes. Standing is encouraged. However, the available seating will be disinfected just prior to the event for those in attendance who do require to be seated. Please do not relocate any available seating as it is spaced appropriately.
12. Parking is available just east of the entrance. There are no washroom facilities at this location. If the ground is saturated from a recent rainfall, the short walking path may be too soft for motorized mobility devices. Please dress for the weather.
13. A representative of the Province of Saskatchewan will be in attendance to unveil the plaque. A photo-op will be provided, with a maximum **two persons** taking photos at any one time, spaced 2 meters apart from each other and from the subject(s) of the photograph. These two photograph locations will be marked. Please be patient while waiting your turn to take your photographs.
14. All attendees not from the same household or family circle are required to remain 2 meters apart from all others at all times.
15. Family members of Gerry Argue will be in attendance. Please refrain from any physical contact with them. (Hugs, kisses, handshakes, etc).
16. Please refrain from touching the plaque after the unveiling.
17. Signage stating these Covid-19 requirements will be posted at the entrance and on the resort village's website. Those choosing not to abide with them will be reminded then requested to leave if the infractions continue.
