**BACKGROUND FOR AGENDA ITEM #3 OF THE FEBRUARY 14, 2026 SPECIAL MEETING OF COUNCIL OF THE RESORT VILLAGE OF SUNSET COVE**

Section 82(1) of *The Municipalities Act* states the following:

*“Each member of council is to be paid any remuneration and benefits and any reimbursement or allowances for expenses that may be fixed by the council.”*

Further, Section 128(1) of *The Municipalities Act* states the following:

*“A council shall ensure that public notice is given before initially considering any report respecting a matter listed in clause 127(b), (e), (i), (j), (m), (o), (p) or (s).”*

where Section 127(o) of *The Municipalities Act* is the setting of remuneration levels for Council.

Council last set its level of remuneration by a resolution of Council in December 2010. No adjustments have been made since that time.

Council is proposing that levels of remuneration be adjusted to reflect 2026 values. Table 1 below summarizes the changes.

<b>Special Meeting Fee for all (per meeting)</b>	\$50	\$70

1. Based on the Saskatchewan Consumer Price Index Annual Average as published by Stats Canada (see attached).

Further, Council is proposing that annual increases to remuneration levels be provided to reflect provincial inflation rates, based on the Saskatchewan Consumer Price Index Annual Average as published by Stats Canada, not to exceed 3%. This aligns with the policy for remuneration increases for provincial MLAs. Any increases in excess of provincial inflation rates would continue to require Public Notice.

The resolution is proposed to be passed at the February 14, 2026 Special Meeting of Council, as follows:

*That, effective January 1, 2026, the remuneration for the members of Council of the Resort Village of Sunset Cove be set as follows:*

- *Mayor - \$175/month;*
- *Deputy Mayor and Councilors - \$140/month; and*
- *Special meeting fee for all (per meeting) - \$70/month.*

*Further, that the members of Council for the Resort Village of Sunset Cove receive an annual remuneration increase in alignment with annual average Consumer Price Index for Saskatchewan as published by Stats Canada, not to exceed 3%.*
