The following information is provided by the Resort Village of Sunset Cove as an update for residents.

Road Repairs

We are pleased to report that the planned road maintenance has been completed on Mountain Drive for 2026, including:

- Filling potholes;
- Grading;
- Dust Control application. The same calcium chloride treatment was used this year as has been used for several years. Council continues to research a more permanent solution to dust suppression; and
- Speed bumps installed



To assist in reducing road maintenance costs, residents are asked to not accelerate when going up the hill out of the village. Acceleration results in washboard on the hill, which requires grading to smooth over. NOTE - the speed limit remains 15 km/hr until past the waste bins at the top of the hill.

Invasive Species

Council reminds residents to be mindful of controlling invasive species in our environments.



Creeping purple bellflower continues to be of concern in our village. Creeping bellflower's pleasing appearance is often mistaken for a desirable garden plant but is actually quite invasive and can aggressively invade lawns and gardens.

Emilee will be pulling it along the road allowance and on public / municipal reserve lands. Residents are asked to remove these plants from their properties to reduce the risk of spread throughout the village.

The Village will be identifying properties with purple bellflower and advising owners to remove it.

Boat Launch

The boat launch located at the public beach will have additional rock added this summer. We are waiting on approval from the Watershed Authority to do this annual work. Residents are reminded to not spin their wheels when using the boat launch, as this causes excessive rutting, requiring repair. It is recommended that a 4-wheel drive vehicle, in low 4x4, be used when launching / loading boats.

Lot 10, Block 3, Plan 102467011 (Formally Hawthorne Road)

The above property owned by the Resort Village of Sunset Cove has been leased to the two residents on either side of the lot for the duration of 2026. Council continues to deliberate on the future use of this municipal property.

Traffic Safety Review

Each year, Council receives comments on the speed limit and the speed bumps in the village. Some residents want less speed bumps, some more, some want the speed limit increased, some want it left as is. Council is undertaking a traffic safety review to determine the most appropriate speed limit and number of speed bumps for our community. This review includes referencing traffic engineering technical guidelines, as well as applicable provincial and federal legislated requirements. Once the review is complete, the recommendations will be shared with residents.

Waste Management

Residents are once again reminded that the following are NOT to be deposited in the municipality's domestic waste bins:

- Large volumes of trees/brush cuttings;
- Wastes generated through the following activities:
 - Site preparation for development,
 - Construction,
 - Renovations, and
 - Demolition;
- Appliances; and
- Hazardous Materials.

If you are undertaking a project that generates any of the above, please dispose of them at acceptable waste disposal sites, or arrange to have a waste disposal bin temporarily placed on your property.

Also, recently, items that were too large to fit in the bins were left outside the bins. Items left outside the bins will not be picked up by our waste contractor. If items do not fit in the bins, please either break them down so that they do fit in the bins, or dispose of them at the landfill. If these items are yours, please remove them and dispose of them appropriately.



Coming this Summer!

To aid with reducing the volume of wastes disposed of in the bins and provide more recycling options to residents, a metal recycling bin will be placed near the blue bin.



This bin will be there until it is full, or approximately the Thanksgiving long weekend, whichever comes first. Depending on use / demand, it will be placed each summer from approximately the May long weekend to Thanksgiving.

Please note the following rules for use:

Acceptable Materials:

Ferrous Materials:

- Metal barrels (must have lids removed and be cleaned of all contents)
- Metal tanks (must have a large opening to view inside)
- Freezers, fridges, coolers, and A/C equipment (must be drained of all refrigerants)
- BBQs
- Stoves
- Dishwashers
- Farm Machinery
- Buses
- Filing Cabinets

Prohibited Materials:

- Propane tanks
- Plastic gas tanks
- Barbwire / chain link
- Electronics
- Batteries

Non-Ferrous Materials:

- Copper
- Brass
- Aluminum
- Stainless Steel
- Car Batteries
- Catalytic Converters
- Rims
- Aluminum Cans

- Radioactive material
- Ballasts
- Medical scrap
- Scrap containing mercury, lead, asbestos
